



Since 1994, Licking/Knox Goodwill Industries, Inc. has been a part of my life. I started as a Board Trustee and quickly discovered how involved Goodwill is in the community. Then in 2008, I entered into the everyday life of Goodwill when I became the Director of Administration and then named CEO/President in 2011.

Allow me to share how Goodwill reaches out to our employees and the community every day.

Licking/Knox Goodwill offers nine retail stores and donation centers in our small, two county Ohio territory. Our retail stores offer special "Color Tag Sales" almost every day of the year and special bonus sales periodically. Each store has a staffed donation center proudly accepting donations during store business hours. Additionally, we feature unique items on shopgoodwill.com, our online auction store front.

Our warehouse operations received the Goodwill 2011 Retail Excellence Best Performance Award for 89.45% Waste Diversion. In honor of this achievement, 500 trees were planted on our behalf in Kenya.

- 397,505 people shopped our retail stores.
- 79,477 people donated to our retail stores.
- 101 people donated vehicles or vessels to Goodwill Used Cars.

With over 12,000 personalized training hours our Vocational Rehabilitation Division provides a valuable service to individuals in our community including our GoodGuides Youth Mentoring Program, operating locally in the Newark City School District. We currently coordinate mentoring sessions in the high school and two middle schools. Participating students continue to improve their grades, attendance, and involvement in school activities. Our adult clients, including local veterans, have also seen personal improvement. Over 40 were placed into competitive employment and continue to receive follow-up service from our dedicated staff.

- 420 people completed Vocational Rehabilitation services.
- 219 middle and high school students participated in GoodGuides mentoring.
- 26 veterans received Vocational Rehabilitation services.

With janitorial contracts servicing over two-million square feet, we provide a broad range of business services customized to meet the unique needs of our customers. All of our employees receive extensive in-house training and receive third-party certification from BETCO University. We continue to participate in AbilityOne Program. As part of the AbilityOne Program, Goodwill maintains federal contracts and provides employment for people who are blind or have other severe disabilities. In 2012, we received several awards for our service with NISH (Creating Employment Opportunities for People with Significant Disabilities) including the National Council of Work Centers Management Excellence Award given to Ms. Marlynn Grabbin-Saddler for her dedication and service to individuals with disabilities.

- 191 employees worked 322,799 labor hours.
- Awarded the NISH Quality Work Environment, Bronze Level of Achievement.

Licking/Knox Goodwill Industries, Inc. is one of 167 autonomous, worldwide members of Goodwill Industries International. Goodwill has provided quality employment and training services to Licking and Knox counties and Central Ohio private businesses, local, state, and federal agencies since 1957.

Today, Licking/Knox Goodwill employs in excess of 300 people. This includes administrative and management staff who oversee contract work services, retail locations and an internet sales location (www.shopgoodwill.com), vocational rehabilitation services, automotive sales, automotive service, and maintenance divisions.

- 316 people are permanent employees.
- 8,736 employee training hours were completed.

Vocational Rehabilitation

What is Vocational Rehabilitation?

Goodwill Vocational Rehabilitation is a series of programs used to assist an individual's transition into the workforce. Real life people needing real life services are what Goodwill is about. The referring agency is billed for services provided and is kept informed of a client's progress through written reports and evaluations completed by Goodwill's Vocational Rehabilitation Specialists.

Benefits to Employers

Goodwill continually seeks partnerships with local businesses to provide a variety of work opportunities for our Goodwill clients. Employers receive "free labor" in exchange for providing a client the opportunity to transition back into the workforce. The employer is given the opportunity to evaluate the client's work performance to determine if the client may be considered for hire. Also, employers may be eligible for federal tax credits by hiring a Goodwill client.

Goodwill offers specialized programs to benefit both employers and clients. A knowledgeable Vocational Rehabilitation Specialist is assigned to each client and assists throughout the process. Job Coaching is available, as needed, to ensure a smooth transition. Job Retention services are available at no charge for the first 90 days if a client is hired.

Veterans Employment Workshop

Goodwill offers two-day employment workshops for veterans. During the course of a workshop, a veteran receives the resources necessary to obtain and maintain employment. Summer Youth Program

Summer Youth Programs are intended to promote a student's transition from high school to post-secondary education, vocational training, or integrated employment. Services may include an evaluation of the consumer's vocational needs, instruction on vocational topics such as interviewing skills, work behaviors, basic job readiness skills, and independent living skills, as well as integrated, community based work experiences. Staff work with students to learn job tasks and skills needed in the workplace. Students are paid Ohio minimum wage for work time.

Youth Programs



W.I.A. Youth Works

W.I.A. Youth Works is a 16-week program serving out-of-school youth ages 16-21 in a paid work setting. Participants gain valuable work and life skills. Participants will also receive support services such as case management and access to various educational opportunities. The long-term goal for participants is the opportunity to obtain permanent employment and/or enrollment in a formal education program. This program is funded by the Licking County Department of Job and Family Services and The United Way.

GoodGuides™

The GoodGuides Youth Mentoring Program provides a structured "time out" during the school day, helping youth (ages 12-18) establish positive relationships with adults and older peers, while:

- Building Self-Esteem
- Exposing Youth to Post-Secondary Education and Career Options
- Setting Goals
- Motivating Youth to Stay in School

GoodGuides also provides youth with quarterly activities to facilitate:

- Greater Connection to the Community
- Career Awareness and Exploration
- Positive Social Engagement
- This Program is funded by The United Way.





Steps to Donate



Spirit Line by LICCO

A Community Partnership - In March 2012, a partnership between Licking/Knox Goodwill and LICCO was formed. Goodwill became the first major distributor for the Spirit Line of jewelry.

In less than a year, Licking/Knox Goodwill sold over 19,000 pieces of handmade Spirit Line jewelry. The success of the partnership has led to new products and designs many of which are exclusively available at Licking/Knox Goodwill retail stores and auctioned online at shopgoodwill.com.

New Furniture

Starting in November 2011, Licking/Knox Goodwill started selling Coaster brand furniture at the Goodwill Unlimited Store, bringing new furniture sales to our customers.

This success led to the addition of Ashley Signature Series furniture. We now offer financing through two companies and have expanded new furniture to other locations, including our Parrott Street Store in Mount Vernon, Ohio.

Unlimited Bargains

Many Licking/Knox Goodwill locations now sell "distressed" merchandise which we call Unlimited Bargains. These major retailer returns consist of a little bit of everything like lamps, bedding, exercise equipment, toys, games, home décor, patio furniture, and even the kitchen sink. We never know what surprises will come off the truck.

Managers are responsible for conducting this training utilizing a Leader's Guide to ensure consistency of all information.











Ongoing training of core competencies took place monthly with the worksite Manager as the facilitator, and the Training Coordinator observing and providing presentation feedback to them. As each Managers' training skill levels increased, the Training Coordinator began stepping away, knowing the employees were receiving effective training. In 2013, the Managers will continue to conduct the training on their own using various training techniques they have learned, and with the capability of ensuring comprehension from all employees.

Driver Training

Driver Training went high tech in 2012! Through The Philadelphia Insurance Company, all authorized drivers now take an on-line interactive defensive driving course with a quiz at the end that must be passed before they are permitted to operate company vehicles or utilize personal vehicles for company business. Upon successful completion of the course, the employee receives a certificate "authorizing" them to drive for the company. The training has been well received by employees, and the training is much more effective because it is interactive and self-paced.

Campus Commitment

Over 50 students from Central Ohio Technical College and The Ohio State University Newark Campus spread out across several Licking/Knox Goodwill sites to volunteer for 2012 Campus Commitment. Volunteers painted fence, washed cars, cleaned shelving, sorted donations, and assisted in the remodeling of the Union Street Store.

Because our painting project was so large, a smaller group of 10 returned to the Goodwill Unlimited Store to finish the job. Overall, Campus Commitment contributed over 225 volunteer hours.

PNB Cares

Each year, Park National Bank coordinates volunteer efforts for their employees. For two weeks in October 2012, 78 volunteers assisted in landscaping the Licking/Knox Goodwill Administrative Offices. It was no easy task. The volunteers helped remove old plants, prep flowerbeds, then remove and replace landscape timber. Their contributions totaled over 300 volunteer hours.



Pony Express

Pony Express is a recreational horseback riding program for children with disabilities. Licking/Knox Goodwill offers six-week sessions in the spring and fall. Volunteers from the community coordinate crafts and snacks, while the local StableMates 4-H Club supplies horses and the majority of the volunteers. Children take turns riding horses around an arena and stop to play games, like basketball, while still on the horse.

Homeless Housing Project

Goodwill, in collaboration with the Licking County Coalition for Housing, has three efficiency apartments and two homes to provide transitional housing for the community. Veterans are given preference and eligibility is determined by the Coalition.

Transportation and Facilities Division

The Transportation Division services Goodwill fleet vehicles including those used to transport employees to and from Goodwill work sites. Facilities personnel provide general maintenance for Goodwill sites and equipment.

C.A.R.F Accreditation

Licking/Knox Goodwill Industries, Inc. maintains accreditation in Employment Skills Training Services through the Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities (CARF). This accreditation represents the highest level of accreditation that can be awarded to an organization and shows the organization's substantial conformance to CARF standards.

Emergency Voucher Program

Retail stores provide emergency clothing assistance to residents of Licking County. Eligibility is determined by area agencies who issue vouchers on behalf of Goodwill. Vouchers are issued to adults once every year and children under the age of 18 every six months.

C.A.R.E. About Safety Program

The C.A.R.E program provides postage paid feedback forms at all Goodwill worksites. Employees can fill out the form to address safety concerns, suggest safety ideas, or simply to express a positive or negative safety action they have observed. These forms are submitted to the Director of Facilities and are reviewed by Goodwill's Safety Committee.

The AbilityOne Program is administered by the Committee for Purchase From People Who Are Blind or Severely Disabled with assistance from National Industries for the Blind and NISH - Creating Employment Opportunities for People with Severe Disabilities.

As part of the AbilityOne Program, Goodwill is able to bid for federal contracts and provide employment for people who are blind or have other severe disabilities.
