- What someone says in mentoring, shares, or does, stays in mentoring.
- Violence or bullying in mentoring is unacceptable.

Who Can Enroll?

- Targeted youth are grades 7-12
- Enrolled in a participating school

How Do I Enroll?

- Ask a teach at your school
- A teacher will tell you when and where to be
- The first time you attend you will have to fill out a 1 page form about yourself

- Direct mentoring services to youth
- Pass extensive background check
- Be a friend

Adult Mentor Pre-Service Requirements

- Written application
- Criminal history check and Child Protective Services Registry check with clearance to work with children
- Provide one personal references
- Training and orientation
