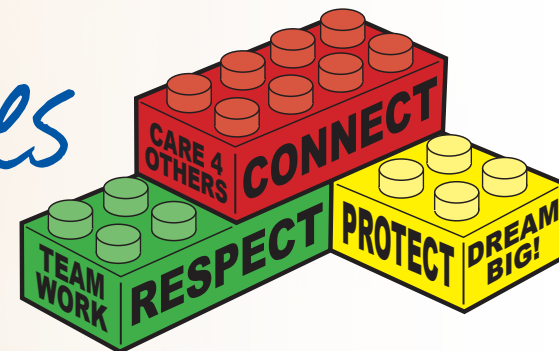

Youth Mentoring Program



GoodGuides builds on best practices and evidence-based approaches to mentoring through character building, life skills, and community partnerships. The program is one day a week, during the fall and spring school semesters. Activities and discussion topics are designed to teach students to interact with others and to become more involved with their families and the community.

ELIGIBILITY

If you meet the following guidelines you can join GoodGuides at any point during the school year.

- Currently Enrolled at a Participating School
- In Grades 6 - 8
- Approved by School Linkage Coordinator(s)

ENROLLMENT

Joining GoodGuides is easy. Follow these steps:

1. Ask a teacher at your school or speak with your school Linkage Coordinator(s).
2. Your Linkage Coordinator will see if GoodGuides Mentoring fits into your class schedule.
3. GoodGuides will be added to your class schedule.
4. Parents and students fill out a simple one-page assessment.

CHARACTER EDUCATION

Explore and build personal character through a series of activities and discussions focusing on:

- Character Traits
- Self-Perception
- Citizenship and Healthy Lifestyles

During the school day we make crafts, play games, and interact with each other to learn more about ourselves, other people, and how to be the best citizen we can be.

LIFE SKILLS

Explore and develop important skills to use in life through a series of activities focusing on:

- Communication
- Team Building
- Goal Setting

During the school day we learn to work as a team and set goals by creating dream boards, team building games, and practicing different kinds of communication.

FUN DAYS

During fall and spring semesters, students can participate in FREE After School Fun Days. Past fun days have included bowling, roller skating, and movies.

When the school semester is almost over, we schedule a special field trip to Goodwill's property, The Grove by the River. Pre-registration is required to attend.
