

1.22 Licking/Knox Goodwill Foundation

Policy:

It is the policy of Licking/Knox Goodwill Industries, Inc. to support and enhance the organization's mission by providing funds for training, employment, and support services to employees, Career Services clients, and high school seniors who have a disability or other barrier to employment.

Procedure:

The Licking/Knox Goodwill Foundation shall offer the following grants:

- Scholarships for post-secondary education, including trade schools, professional certifications, Associate, Bachelor, Master, or PHD programs. (Other, continuing education programs will be considered on a case by case basis.)
- Essential transportation needs
- Temporary housing
- Other, employment related grants as may identified by the Licking/Knox Goodwill Foundation Committee

Licking/Knox Goodwill Foundation funds shall be administered jointly by Licking County Foundation and the Licking/Knox Goodwill Foundation Committee, with oversight from the Licking/Knox Goodwill Industries, Inc. Board of Trustees.

Licking/Knox Foundation Committee membership criteria and responsibilities, grant eligibility, fund characteristics, disbursements and marketing shall be governed by the Licking/Knox Goodwill Foundation document, dated June, 2013, and any and all amendments thereto.
