

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

## Applicants must meet all of the following criteria:

- Resident of Licking or Knox County and/or relative of a current Goodwill Employee, Board Member, or Career Services Participant.
- High school junior or senior for the 2021-2022 school year.
- Will attend trade school in lieu of attending a traditional high school for your junior or senior year.

Are you a graduating high school senior or an adult who wants to further your education?

The Licking/Knox Goodwill Foundation specializes in offering scholarships for individuals who want to pursue training through a trade school or professional certification.

Scholarships are also available for those working toward an Associate, Bachelor, Master, or Doctoral degree. Preference is given to applicants attending a trade school or applicants with a disability or other barrier to employment.

### **ELIGIBILITY**

# Applicants must meet one of the following criteria:

- Current Goodwill Employee.
- Relative of a current goodwill employee or Board Member.
- Career Services Client current client, or client who successfully completed the Career Services program within the previous twelve months.
- Licking or Knox County Resident with a Disability or Other Barrier to Employment.

# Applicants must meet one of the following criteria:

- Have a high school diploma or GED.
- Be a high school senior who will graduate in 2021.
